Subject: Hauling and Stockpiling of Riprap Material for Plum Creek Environmental Mitigation

Riprap (rounded river rock) material will be hauled to and stockpiled within Chatfield State Park starting as early as July 2017. This material will be used to accomplish the environmental mitigation work along Plum Creek, which includes construction of riffle-type drop structures to stabilize the channel and restore the connection of the overbank to groundwater, which will preserve vegetation and control erosion. Haul trucks will enter the Park through Roxborough Road and proceed to the stockpile area via a temporary haul road. The stockpiled material is anticipated to be approximately two acres in size and up to 15 feet high.
